

## GRANGER WASTE SERVICES

### **TRASH COLLECTION IS EVERY \*WEDNESDAY**

(\*Unless schedule is affected by a major holiday). Trash must be curbside prior to 7:00 a.m. on the day of service. If a holiday affects usual service, pick-up will be the next day..

### **HOUSEHOLD TRASH (Weekly Removal)**

All household trash must be bagged – Loose trash in containers is discouraged.

### **ONE BULK (LARGE) ITEM EVERY WEDNESDAY**

There is no charge for one item. If you place more than one large item curbside the same day, you will be billed for that extra item by Granger. You will need to contact Granger 372-2800 if your large item contains Freon to have that item picked up. A Freon charge may result so ask when you call Granger. Large bulky items may result in a separate truck pick up and may not occur until the next day so please leave out. If item is not picked-up by the next day call City Hall 669-2441. Vehicle tires of any kind are not to be placed curbside. They will not be picked up.

### **EACH HOME IS PROVIDED WITH A 96-GALLON or 65-GALLON GRANGER CONTAINER**

Granger will replace damaged carts free of charge. Call City Hall **517-669-2441** if you wish to replace or exchange your containers.

### **RECYCLE PROGRAM (Bi-Weekly Removal see attached calendar)**

One 96-Gallon recycle cart or one 18-Gallon recycle bin is provided to each residence at no charge. If the residence is sold, the bin must remain with the property.

**NO GLASS** of any kind will be accepted with street-side recycling. A container for glass is available at 907 W. Main Street for glass disposal behind the fire station.

### **SEASONAL COMPOST PROGRAM (Weekly Removal April – November)**

For collection purposes, compost (yard waste) material is defined as: Grass, leaves, shrubs, tree branch trimmings and garden materials.

Yard waste will be picked up in brown paper compost bags or a container with an “X” marked on it. Each compost bag/container must weigh 50 pounds or less.

Shrubs must be cut up into manageable pieces and be free of any root balls. Branch trimmings must be no longer than 4 feet in length and securely tied in bundles. Weeds and grass clippings must be free of dirt before disposal into bag or container.

Granger will take up to 4 compost bags or 4 bundles of trimmed brush, or a combination of the two from each residence weekly.

Plastic bags containing compost will not be picked up and yard waste must be separate from household trash and placed on the opposite side of the drive, if possible.

**\*Day of service may be affected by the following holidays observed by Granger: New Year’s Day; Memorial Day; Independence Day; Labor Day and Christmas Day.**
