Dear Resident/Property Owner:

The Clinton County Road Commission, the City of DeWitt and DeWitt Charter Township will be holding an informational meeting on June 2, 2016, at 6:00 p.m. in the Media Room at the DeWitt High School. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss future road and non-motorized projects related to the Herbison Road corridor.

By working together, the Clinton County Road Commission, the City of DeWitt and DeWitt Charter Township have been able to secure funds from the State of Michigan and the Federal Highway Administration that would allow Herbison Road to be repaved from Old US-27 to Airport Road. In addition, by leveraging these funds, we would be able to add a significant new asset to our community.

Both the City's and the Township's Non-Motorized Transportation Plans identify the addition of a 10-foot non-motorized pathway that would run along Herbison Road from Old US-27 to the existing pathway system at the DeWitt Sports Park and then on to the entrance of the DeWitt School's campus at Panther Drive. We anticipate that this project could start as early as 2017. The project would be broken up into three phases, with one phase occurring each year from 2017 to 2019.



Dear Resident/Property Owner:

Back In June the Clinton County Road Commission, the City of DeWitt and DeWitt Charter Township held a Public Information meeting to discuss the future road and non-motorized pathway projects that are planned along Herbison Road. To recap, the plan calls for the repaving of Herbison Road from Old US-27 to Schavey Road, a 10-foot non-motorized pathway from Old US-27 to the entrance of the DeWitt Public Schools at Panther Drive and we are working with the school district to potentially realign the entrance with East Geneva Drive.

Since that meeting was held several months ago, we wanted to give a quick update on the status of the project. The project is still anticipated to begin in 2017. The engineering firm, C2AE, is currently working on the plans for the project, but as discussed at the meeting in June we expect the project to have some changes as we move along. The following are some of the anticipated changes at this point:

First, the project was originally broken down into three phases/years. It is now anticipated that Phases A and B, will now be completed in one year instead of two. This means that for 2017 the project limits will be from Old US-27 to Turner Road. By doing a larger portion of the project in one year it is expected to help reduce expense and provide a larger connection point, thus improving the immediate benefit for the pathway portion of the project. Additionally, it will reduce the number of years that residents will have to deal with challenges of construction.

Second, is one of the crossings of Herbison Road. At the June meeting we discussed that the pathway will be crossing at Ontonagon Rd. Now that the engineers have begun design they are recommending that the pathway cross at Rambler Road.

Third, instead of stopping the non-motorized pathway at Turner Road in 2017 with the road project, only the pathway would be extended on Herbison Road to make the connection to the existing path at the DeWitt Sports Park.

While there is still a lot of work to continue to move the Herbison Road Project forward, we anticipate this project to start in February or March 2017. This first step would be the removal of any trees that may impact the pathway alignment. Most likely the actual construction of the pathway or repaving of the road would not begin until School is out in June 2017.


